



Growing our Global Internet Outreach



As of last month we now have 82 French lessons on our website, in addition to 149 in Spanish and 522 in English. These new French lessons will mean that Francophones in 44 countries all across the world will be able to do lessons in their own

language. And by early next year we expect to add another 55 lessons in French, providing even more content for these students.

So far this year, our 1 million visitors have viewed over 6 million pages. Our most popular section of online lessons is "Youth World" but the #2 spot is the Spanish section! In fact, 7 out of our top 10 countries are Hispanic (Canada is #4, after the USA, Uruguay and Mexico) so we know that Spanish-speaking youth and adults are making a lot of use of our online lessons. Do pray with us that the French section will also expand.

We are excited to report that PSSM Mailbox Club, a national correspondence ministry in Australia, have just begun using our online system of lessons, awards and database student records, for their own students "Down Under". Opening up our unique Internet resource for other organizations to use is one of the most significant developments for us as we look at the global potential.

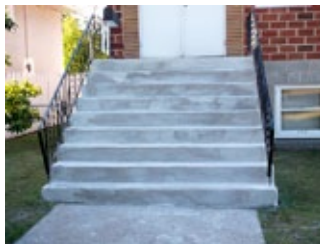
