A Time for Discernment

Deuteronomy 32:28 reads, "They are a nation without sense, there is no discernment in them." (NIV) Could this describe our nation? Think of discernment as "understanding things from God's point of view". Proverbs 2:6 tells us, "For the LORD gives wisdom, and from his mouth come knowledge and understanding." It follows that if we seek the LORD with all our heart, He gives us discernment. If you wish to seek after God with all your heart, there are three things you must do. First, saturate yourself in God's Word. There is no better way to understand things from God's point of view than to read God's Word. Secondly, you must spend time talking to God in prayer. James 1:5 advises, "If any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God." Thirdly, surround

Prudent in Matters

Among many of the good things that were said about David is a statement in 1 Samuel 16:18 where it says he was “prudent in matters.” Another word for prudence is discernment.

Prudence is the wise use of information. We are living in an information age. In fact there is so much information available that today it seems to be more important to know where to find the information than to have it all in your head.

Daniel is told to seal up some things until the time of the end when “Knowledge would be increased and many would run to and fro”. It seems that there is no shortage of information or knowledge. Our problem is prudence or discernment.

This is why we concentrate on giving out the “Truth” in the Bible, and pray that those who hear the truth will be prudent and act on it. In the Bible we find information on God’s one way to get to heaven, and how we can have the assurance of eternal life.
