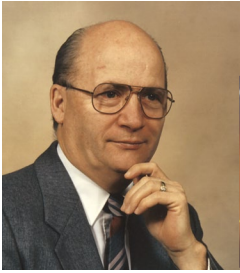

## Times are Changing on the Prairies in Western Canada

The Prairies for hundreds of years was known as *“Oh give me a home, where the buffalo roam, and the deer and the antelope play; Where seldom is heard a discouraging word, and the skies are not cloudy all day.”*

About 100 years ago, it began to be known as *“The Bread Basket of the World”*, with golden fields of grain, and wheat being shipped for food around the world.

Shortly after that the Prairies became the *“Bible Belt of the World”*, transporting the Word of God to nations throughout the world through faith missions and the Bible School movement.

Lately, it is becoming known as the *“Potash Capital of Canada”*, with 60% of the known potash of the world having been found in its heartland, which will be transported by 1,000 rail cars a week to world markets to fertilize crops wherever needed.

Now, the prairies are changing once more with the development of *“The Global Transportation Hub”* by becoming a global hub for rail, truck, oil, natural gas and air transportation just west of Regina.

While this has been happening we at D&J have been establishing *“The Global Information Hub”*, working especially for the last 10 years in transporting Bible lessons through the Internet by the *ubdavid.org* website.



Brian Cummins, our website developer, has produced well over 600 Bible lessons for the Internet in beautiful colour format, including nearly 150 lessons in Spanish. Many tell us it is second to none.

Since 2005 visitors to our website have increased from 19,000 to a quarter million this year, from 50 countries. Our online students are doing well over 20,000 lessons per month. This website “hub” has unlimited possibilities worldwide.

In Daniel 12:4 we read, *“Seal up the Book, O Daniel, until the time of the end: many shall run to and fro throughout the earth, and knowledge shall be increased.”* We are not just working to draw people into this “Global Information Hub”, but into the Heavenly Transportation Hub through accomplishing our goal of seeing thousands accept Christ as Lord and Saviour. ***Will you join us in these exciting days through your prayers and giving?***
